-School Bus Safety-



DO have your child at the bus stop five minutes before it arrives.



DON'T allow your child to run across the street to try and catch a bus.


DO have your child stand far back from the curb when they're waiting for the bus.



DON'T let your child stick anything or any part of their body out of the bus windows.



DO educate your child to use their indoor voices while they're on the bus.



DON'T let your child stand up on the bus unless it is at a complete stop.



DO educate your child to look both ways before crossing the street after exiting the bus, regardless of whether other pedestrians are already walking across.



DON'T allow your child to cross the street behind the bus after exiting – always wait for the bus driver to signal that it is safe before crossing in front of the vehicle.
